

# CIT Woden Campus Construction Look Ahead

November to January 2023

*Work continues on the temporary bus interchange.*

A new town centre precinct is coming to Woden. It will bring state-of-the-art learning facilities, a safer, light rail ready public transport interchange, improved active travel and more green spaces on Woden's eastern side. Construction is underway. This construction look ahead provides a summary of expected activity in the work zones.

## In the Construction Zone

Construction works for the CIT Campus Woden Project continue over November 2022 to January 2023



### Temporary bus interchange opens Term 1, 2023

Construction on a temporary public transport interchange continues on the block bound by Callam, Matilda and Bowes Streets in the Woden Town Centre.

The temporary interchange will allow bus operations to continue safely while construction on the new light rail ready public transport interchange gets underway in early 2023.

The interchange will feature sheltered double platforms with prioritised pedestrian access at the northern and southern entry points.

### Works on Launceston Street

Works to install new traffic lights at the Launceston and Bowes Street intersection are underway. These works

will have some temporary impacts to traffic and pedestrians routes through this intersection.

The Launceston and Callam Street intersection is now signalised with new traffic lights and is open to traffic, however works continue around pedestrian crossings, within the road and verges.

All pedestrian crossings to the Launceston and Easty Street intersection are now complete and open for use.

Other pavement, utility connections, fencing and landscaping works continue to prepare the area for the opening of the Launceston Street bus layover early next year.

### Works on Easty Street

New bus layovers and driver amenities are now complete and operational on Easty Street. Some minor works continue within the road and verges. Footpath reinstatement

works within Arabanoo Park are also now complete and open for public use.

### Reminder - Matilda and Callam Street closures



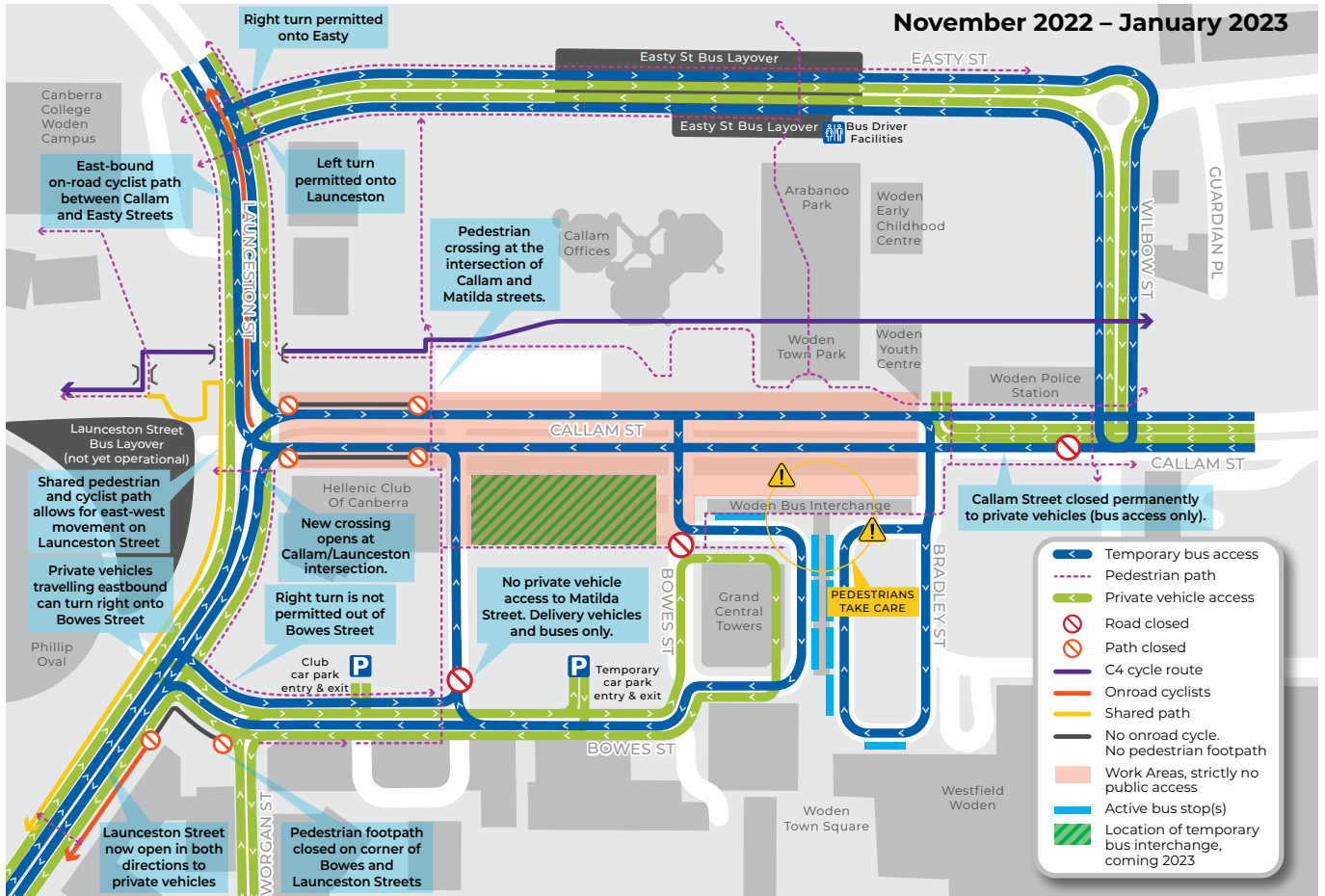
More prominent signage has been installed to remind road users to not enter the section of Callam Street between Bradley and Matilda Streets. This section of road is now permanently closed to make way for the new light rail ready Woden Public Transport Interchange now under construction. Only buses and construction vehicles can enter this section of road. Matilda Street is also temporarily closed to private vehicles as construction of a temporary bus interchange continues.
