Back on track to school!

Planning to catch a Transport Canberra bus or light rail service to school this year? Here are some tips:

- Plan your journey using the online TC Journey Planner.
- Top up, purchase and register your MyWay card online or at one of many recharge agents across Canberra.
- Stay COVID Safe. Remember, no cash is being accepted on bus services and entry and exit is from the rear door only.
- Walking, cycling or scooting to school is a great way to stay COVID Safe. Use crossings and underpasses and don't forget your helmet!

COVID-19 vaccine roll out

A COVID-19 vaccine program will be rolled out nationally in early 2021. The ACT Government will provide Canberrans access to safe and effective COVID-19 vaccines.

Initial doses will be made available to priority groups. To keep our community safe, we must continue practising good hygiene and physical distancing, use the Check In CBR app, and get tested if you have any COVID-19 symptoms – no matter how mild.

Upgrades for Belco Town Centre

Demolition of the former police and emergency services facilities in Lathlain Street, Belconnen, is underway and the planning for future Town Centre development will continue during 2021.

Planning for the redeveloped precinct includes a public park, new residential and office buildings and the extension of Walder Street to Lathlain Street. Along with existing restaurants on the eastern side of Lathlain Street, the development will create an exciting new main street in the town centre.



Creating a more sustainable Canberra

Through investments in the 2020-21 Budget we are transitioning to a cleaner future and providing Canberrans opportunities to contribute to our vision.

Zero-interest loans up to \$15,000 will be established for households and not-for-profit community organisations to invest in rooftop solar panels, household battery storage, zero emission vehicles and efficient electric appliances.

All new zero emissions vehicles purchased in the ACT from May 2021 until June 2024 will receive two-year free registration and work will commence in 2021 on delivering ACT's Big Battery.

Helping the community recover from COVID-19

Through the 2020-21 Budget the ACT Government is continuing to support businesses, industries and community members most affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

- The ChooseCBR program will receive a funding boost to drive more sales through local business.
- The Fast Track infrastructure program will continue to protect and create local jobs, whilst delivering upgraded facilities for the community.
- A Future Jobs Fund will be established that includes a grant program targeting growth industries and higher education.
- More mental health and wellbeing services will be provided to meet the additional needs of the community.

NEW Walk-in Health Centre

Feasibility and site selection work will soon begin for four new Walk-in Health Centres across Canberra, including one for the West Belconnen community.

Belconnen road projects

Upgrades are underway across the Belconnen road network to improve safety and travel times.

We know this may disrupt the routes you normally take, and our project teams will be working to minimise the impacts and complete works as quickly as possible.

Construction details

To complete these projects as quickly as possible, construction hours may include both day and nightworks.

Dayworks: Monday to Friday: 7am to 6pm /
Saturday: 8am to 4pm

Nightworks: Sunday to Friday: 8pm to 6am

To facilitate the works, temporary lane and/or intersection closures may be required.

Roadside signage will be in place ahead of any closures to notify road users and local residents.

Road connecting Belconnen & Gungahlin

The road connecting Belconnen and Gungahlin is being upgraded to a dual carriageway between Ginninderra Drive and the Barton Highway. The project will also include:

- 6.4 kilometres of new on-road cycle lanes
- traffic lights at Dumas Street and Owen Dixon Drive intersections
- a reduced speed limit to minimise noise levels for nearby residents
- a replacement of all existing underpass structures including lighting and connecting paths
- additional and upgraded bus stops.

This project will be delivered in two stages:

1. Ginninderra Drive to Baldwin Drive and Chuculba Crescent to the Barton Highway
2. Baldwin Drive to Chuculba Crescent.

Work has started on stage one, with work expected to commence on stage two in the middle of this year. All works are expected to be completed in the middle of 2023.

Renaming of the road connecting Belconnen and Gungahlin

The ACT Government has commenced the process to rename the road connecting Ginninderra Drive and the Barton Highway to Gundaroo Drive.

This is expected to be formalised in the coming weeks. Roadside signage will be updated once this is complete.

Safer Belco roads

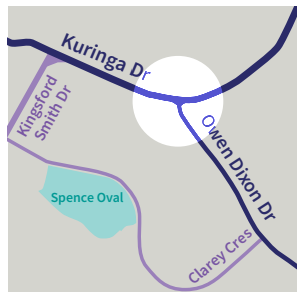
We are improving safety at key Belconnen intersections by installing traffic lights.

Construction is currently underway on the below three intersections with completion expected mid-year.

Kuringa Drive/Owen Dixon Drive, Evatt

In addition to traffic lights, this project will deliver:

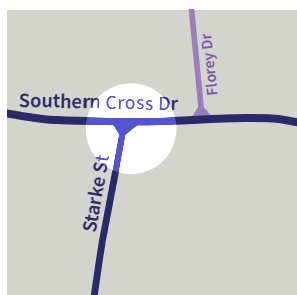
- an additional through lane westbound (towards Owen Dixon Drive) on Kuringa Drive
- a right turn lane from Kuringa Drive onto Owen Dixon Drive
- a new three-metre wide asphalt shared path along Kuringa Drive between the Barton Highway and Owen Dixon Drive
- new signalised pedestrian crossings
- upgraded footpaths and kerb ramps
- landscaping, including grassing and shrubs.



Southern Cross Drive/Starke Street, Holt

In addition to traffic lights, this project will deliver:

- a widened eastbound carriageway (heading towards Belconnen) on Southern Cross Drive at the intersection
- new signalised pedestrian crossings
- upgraded footpaths and kerb ramps, including 300 metres of new shared paths
- landscaping, including grassing and shrubs.

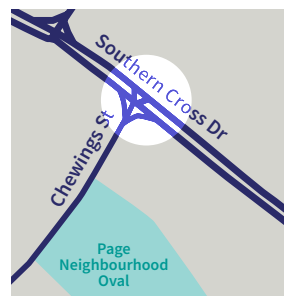
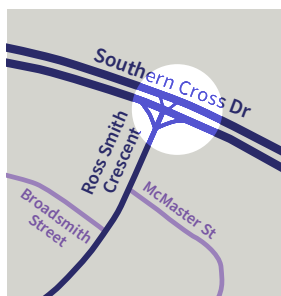
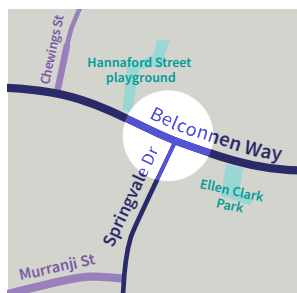


To access the Kippax Group Centre during construction, please consider alternate routes including Drake Brockman Drive and the Starke Street entrance closest to Kingsford Smith Drive.

Belconnen Way/Springvale Drive, Hawker

In addition to traffic lights, this project will deliver:

- a new zebra crossing and pedestrian island on the left turn lane from Belconnen Way to Springvale Drive
- new signalised pedestrian crossings
- upgraded footpaths and kerb ramps
- new on-road cycle lanes on both sides of Belconnen Way at the intersection
- landscaping, including grassing and shrubs.



Southern Cross Drive and Ross Smith Crescent/Chewings Street

Later this year traffic lights will also be installed at these two intersections as part of the Australian Government's Black Spot Program.
