"Taking small steps will ultimately lead to a better world."

That's the message from
Pac Le'Mond owner Paul
Dennison, who has been
encouraging customers of
his Hume-based food
packing wholesaler business
to switch away from
single-use plastic items.

"It's the right thing to do," Paul said. "The changes demonstrate to the wider community that we're serious about doing something here." On 1 July, the ACT will commence a ban on the sale and supply of selected single-use plastic products, which includes single-use plastic cutlery, single-use plastic drink stirrers and expanded polystyrene takeaway containers.
