Temporary car park closure, Acton Waterfront

New construction compound on Acton Waterfront

Part of the ACT Government Acton Waterfront surface car park (compound C on map below) will temporarily close from **15 May 2023**. The car park will be converted for use as a construction site compound. Signage is now displayed onsite.

Construction site compounds for this project are also set up at compound A (ACT Government surface City Hill carpark), and compound B (ACT Government surface car park at 41 Marcus Clarke Street). Compound D (ACT Government surface car park at the corner of London Circuit and

Edinburgh Avenue) is also closed following the closure of London Circuit. See map below for details.

Alternative parking can be found at Acton Waterfront, as well as:

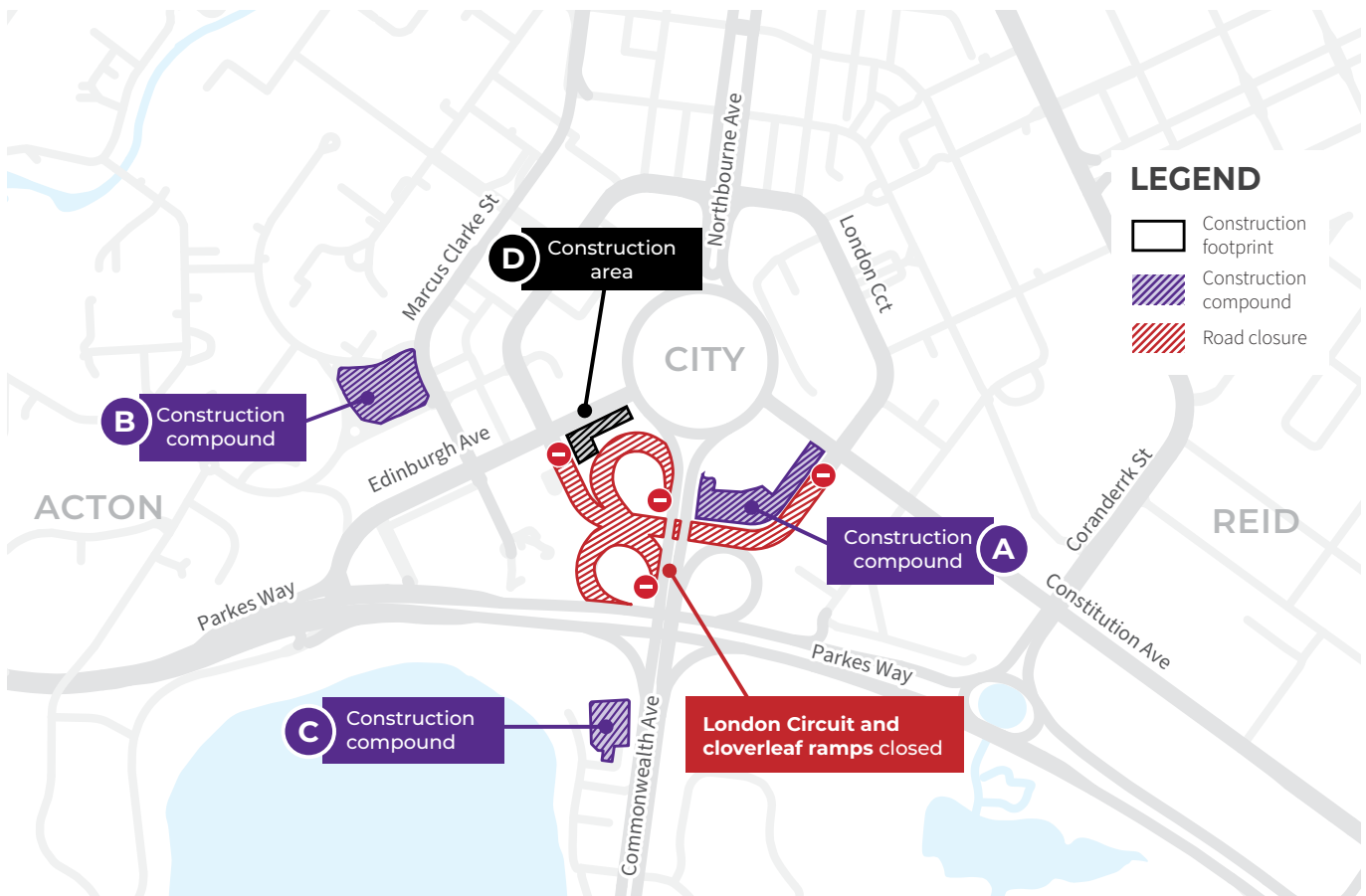
- National Capital Authority surface car park at Regatta Place

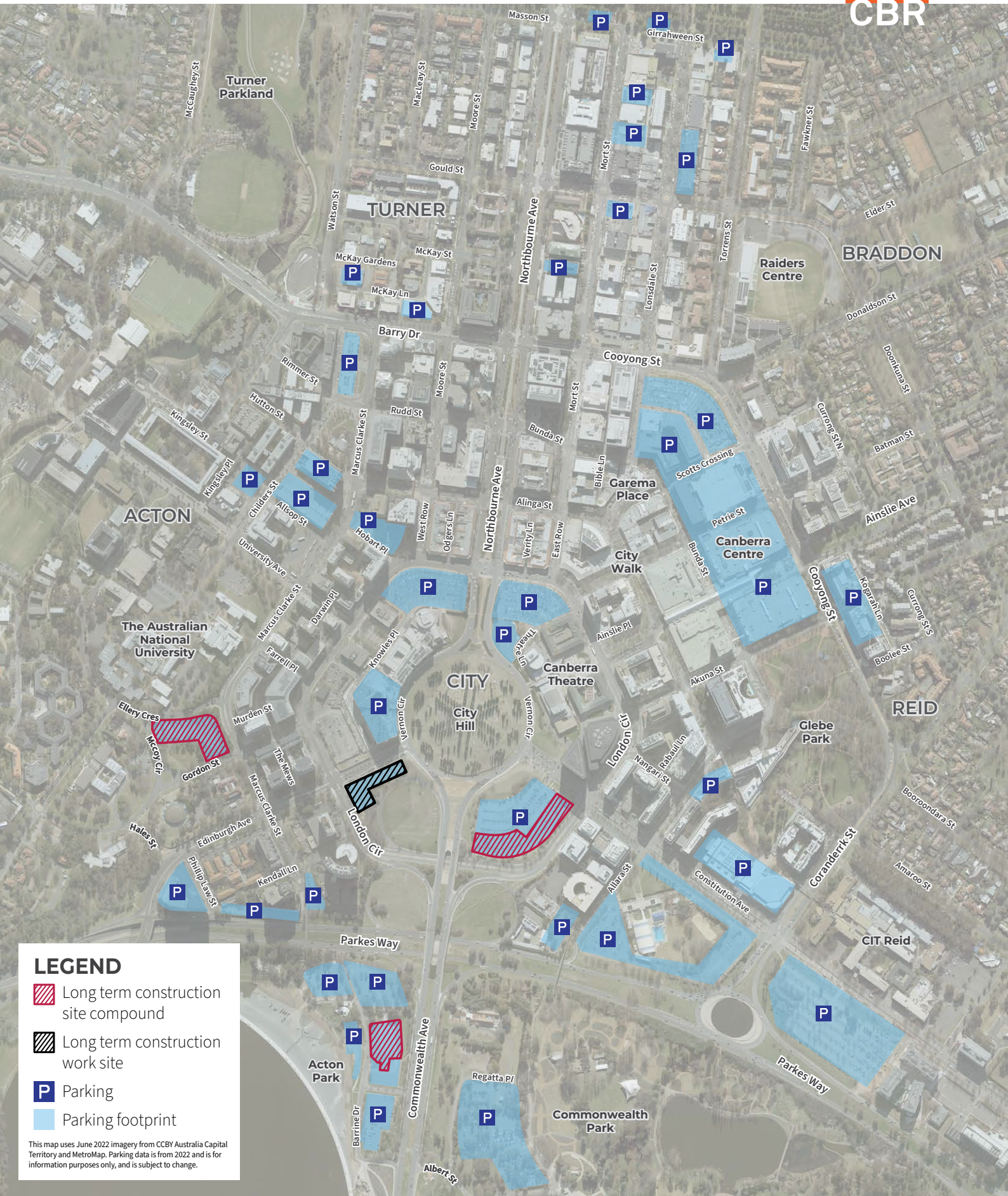
