to Woden


The next stage of the light rail network, between the city and Commonwealth Park, will feature wireless infrastructure. It will also use on-board green energy batteries and grassed tracks to maintain Canberra's iconic city views.

The extension is due to open in 2024. It will add 1.7km of track along the western side of London Circuit and onto Commonwealth Avenue, finishing at Commonwealth Park. The following stage will connect Commonwealth Park to Woden.
