CANBERRA HOSPITAL EXPANSION PROJECT UPDATE



MORE REFURBISHMENTS COMPLETED

The ACT Government has delivered another two projects with more due for completion by mid year.

New Child at Risk Health Unit

The new Child at Risk Health Unit provides critical services to vulnerable youth in the Canberra region. It now has new accommodation with more space and a new and improved environment for children.

Teaching and training facilities

Also complete are upgrades to Building 4. These provide new teaching and training spaces for the Australian National University, and a refurbished library is now being enjoyed by staff and students.

Building 8

Construction of the new Building 8, set to house the Canberra Sexual Health Centre, Staff Development Unit, Surgical Training Centre and hospital administration functions is also on track for completion mid this year.

Other works

The Canberra Hospital expansion has already delivered a new administrative building, relocated utility services under Hospital Road and is on track to deliver more staff carparking by mid 2021.

New emergency, surgical and critical healthcare building

Later this year demolition will start on Building 5 and Building 24, which will allow preparatory works to commence on the site of the new emergency, surgical and critical healthcare building. The Development Application has been lodged and will be open for public comment in the coming weeks.
