The ACT Government is building light rail to Woden to help make Canberra a more connected, sustainable, and vibrant city. This construction Look Ahead provides a summary of expected activity in the work zones for the month ahead on Raising London Circuit – an enabling project for light rail to Woden.



Construction update – early works on Raising London Circuit

Early utility relocation works on Raising London Circuit are winding down and nearing completion in the next few months.

In July the team will continue completing reinstatement works on Edinburgh Avenue and Constitution Avenue and connecting a new watermain.

Demobilisation of the site compound at Constitution Avenue carpark is now complete with demobilisation of the second compound at Marcus Clarke to be done in July. This involves removing all established materials and leaving the area as it was before works started.

Water and telecommunications service providers continue to undertake connections with new and existing infrastructure. Whilst these works are occurring there will be traffic changes and pedestrian and traffic management in place to ensure safety.

Service providers undertaking connections will issue a notification to customers if there are any scheduled impacts to existing services.





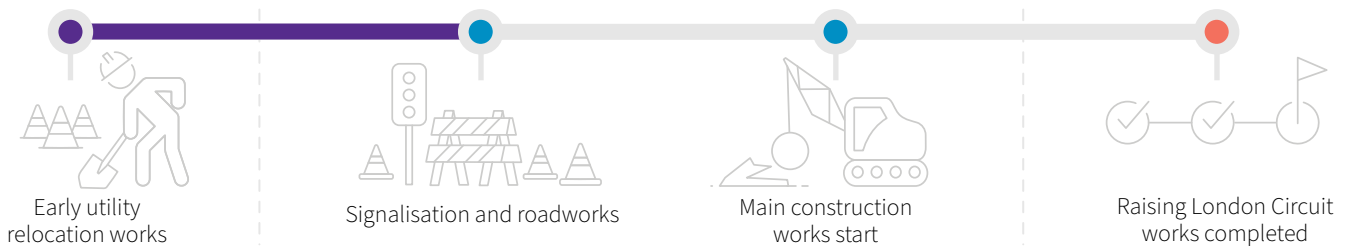
Raising London Circuit moves to next phase

With early utility relocation work finishing up in the next few months and a contractor now in place, main construction on Raising London Circuit is due to start later this year.

Raising London Circuit is an enabling project for the extension of light rail to Woden with construction expected to take around two years to complete.

This important road project will close the gap between the city and lake delivering more accessible footpaths, dedicated cycle lanes and more vibrant and useable public spaces.

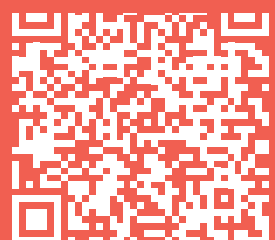

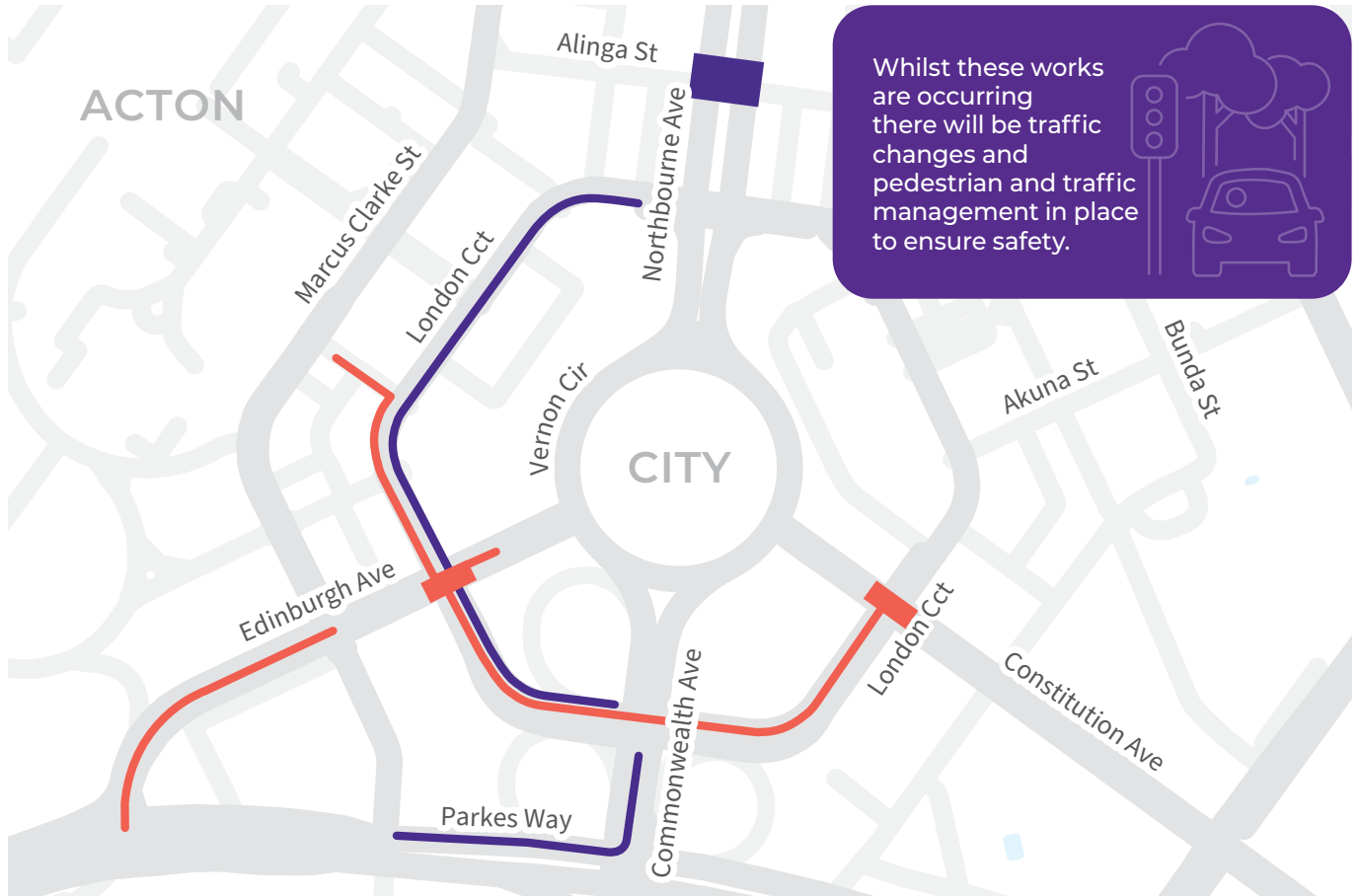

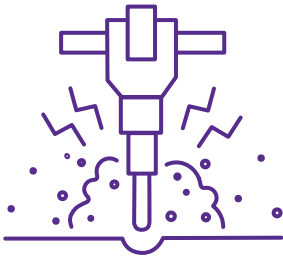
Overall project works in July



Whilst these works are occurring there will be traffic changes and pedestrian and traffic management in place to ensure safety.

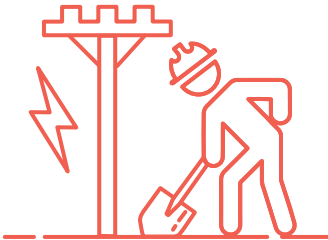

Investigation works

Potholing and survey investigation works will be done throughout July along London Circuit to investigate ground and underground conditions. These investigations involve minor excavation works, survey pickup and surface reinstatement. As part of this work, traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place.



Telecommunications works

Service providers such as Optus and TPG will be carrying out conduit installation, testing, commissioning and cutover works as outlined on the map. This work will be ongoing throughout July. Some additional excavation, trenching and pavement reinstatement by telecommunications providers will also be carried out crossing Farrell Place, along London Circuit to Edinburgh Avenue.
