BIRRIGAI ROCK ART SITE BLOCK 10, SECTION 0, PADDYS RIVER

The nomination was given to the Council on 3 December 2025 and accepted at meeting 139 on 18 February 2026.

The Birrigai Rock Art Site is an example of Aboriginal rock art and has historical, spiritual, and cultural value as a tangible connection to Aboriginal ancestors. Rock art in the ACT is important for providing insight into past Aboriginal lifeways, and the place is likely to be significant to the Aboriginal community for preserving knowledge and story.
