

Period Products Access Arrangements

Location:

ACT Law Courts – 4 Knowles Place, Civic

Purpose

Under section 10 of the *Period Products and Facilities (Access) Act 2023*, the ACT Government must maintain written arrangements for access to period products at public places on the Suitable Places List, available on the relevant ACT Government website. Access Arrangements set out how:

- A person can access period products in a way that respects their dignity.
- A reasonable range of period products will be available at the place.

Access arrangements

Period products are available in dispensers installed in three locations within ACT Courts, including:

- To the left of the Registry counter, outside the ground floor bathrooms. This is the closest location to the ACT Courts entry
- Opposite the Legal Aid Office, inside the Female bathroom
- Within the Children's Court, inside the Accessible bathroom.

Products are also available within the Remote Witness Suite bathroom.

Signs will be used to indicate that free period products are available at the location. This will include signs outside and within the specific bathrooms that have dispensers installed.

Range of products

Sanitary pads and tampons will be available to the public in ACT Courts.

Principle of Dignity

Products are available outside bathrooms, and within unisex bathrooms where possible. This supports all people who menstruate to access the products they need discreetly and privately.
