## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the Freedom of Information Act 2016 (the Act), received by Major Projects Canberra (MPC) on 15 December 2020, in which you sought access to:

- 1. All documents and correspondence in from May to December 2019 to and from the ACT Property Group in relation to the Gungahlin Leisure Centre and its pools, in particular the issues with the 50 metre pool, including:
  - information about problems with pool,
  - costings to fix the pool,
  - the work which has been done to date to fix the pool and by whom,
  - which experts and other people have been engaged to do work and give advice and other information about the pool, and how much that advice and work has cost,
  - any timeline about how long the work will take and when work may start and finish,
  - any information about whether the pool will reopen,
  - any discussion about if the 50m pool might never reopen and other options that have been considered, such as building a new pool, closing the pool indefinitely.
- 2. All documents and correspondence from May to December 2019 from and to the Gungahlin Leisure Centre about its 50 metre pool.
- 3. All documentation and correspondence from May to December 2019 to and from Sports Minister Yvette Berry about the Gungahlin Leisure Centre and its pools, in particular the issues with the 50 metre pool
- 4. All documentation and correspondence from May to December 2019 to and from Chief · Minister Barr about the Gungahlin Leisure Centre and its pools, in particular the issues with the 50 metre pool.
- 5. Any documentation between Minister Berry and Chief Minister Barr about Gungahlin Leisure Centre from May to December 2019.

## Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Chief Projects Officer under section 18 of the Act to deal with access application made under Part 5 of the Act.

## Timeframes

On 18 March 2021, you received a Notice of Decision letter informing you that I had decided to defer access to sixty-two (62) documents that affected third parties had objected to disclosure. We have since found two (2) further documents that were deferred access due to third party objection. The third parties had 20 working days to apply to the ACT Ombudsman for a review of my decision

The third-party review period expired on 16 April 2021. The third parties did not request a review of my decision.

## **Third Party Consultation**

In making this decision, I completed consultation in accordance with section 38 of the Act. The views of all third parties were considered when making this decision.

### **Decision on access**

I have included at **Attachment A** to this decision the schedule of relevant documents that were previously withheld. This provides a description of each document that falls within the scope of your request and the access decision for each of those documents. **Attachment B** includes all the documents previously withheld.

In addition to documents already released to you, I have decided to provide access to twenty-one (21) documents in full and forty-three (43) documents in part which were identified as withheld in my Notice of Decision to you on 18 March 2021.

### **Materials considered**

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- the Act; and
- the content of the documents that fall within the scope of your request.

### **Online Publishing – Disclosure Log**

Under section 28 of the Act, MPC maintains, an official online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application and my decision will be published in the MPC disclosure log between three (3) and ten (10) days after the date of the decision. #### **Ombudsman Review**

Hi

Thank you for providing your advice.

I note your comment "We understand that the pool filling was scheduled for Friday July 26 however was delayed due to other work (not part of the tiling rectification work) being undertaken and preventing the commencement of filling the pool. Delaying the pool fill for a further 80+ hours may have contributed to tiles becoming drummy as a result of the base structure shrinking".

ACT Property Group (ACTPG) believes this is inaccurate, as the caulking of the floor was only completed on the afternoon of Tuesday, 23 July 2019, so the earliest the pool could have been filled was the afternoon of Saturday, 27 July 2019, given the minimum curing time for the caulking is four days (with the manufacturer recommended curing time being seven days).

Noting the condition of the facility following works on the pool gutters, ACTPG arranged to have it cleaned on Sunday, 28 July 2018, with the pool ready to be refilled on the same day. This was three days before the refill date (1 August 2019) provided by ADCO in their schedule (see attached), which I believe you assisted in preparing. I note the ADCO schedule also includes a seven day curing time.

Your comments appear to imply that the Territory is at fault by claiming works commissioned by the Territory delayed the filling of the pool by "80+ hours". I would appreciate if you could address this point and amend your report noting the above information.

Further to this, can you please clarify your comment regarding "Option 1" for the rectification of the tiles found to be drummy on the Monday, 29 July 2019 - "all costs of this option would not be the responsibility of the <u>contractor</u>". By "contractor", are you referring to ADCO or a contractor of ADCO?

Morning

After yesterday's meeting Gran Voysey (ACTPG) and Schedule 2.2(a)(ii) (Crystal Pools) conducted a further inspection of the pool floor tiles and discovered there are approximately 415 white and 5 blue tiles that are drummy and will need replacing. After their inspection, filling of the pool commenced up to a nominal depth of between 100mm – 150mm as agreed at the meeting.

Please can you advise on the following:

- Required depth of water to fill pool 100mm or higher
- Length of time to leave water in
- Draining and drying times
- Removal of tiles
- Retiling and grouting
- Curing/drying times
- Refill pool and heating
- Date back in operation

The current rectification program shows the pool reheating starting 5/8/19 and the pool being back in operation 9/8/19 if this in not achievable, we need to advise the YMCA and our Minister on any delays and would appreciate your advice.





Good evening Grant,

As raised several times by Crystal Pools, Ceramic Solutions and Hydrautech that the longer pool remains empty in an unstable environment the greater the risk grows on the pool structure as it is constantly contracting and expanding due to thermal and compression factors.

By putting water on the base of the pool it will minimise the risk of future tile delamination from the substrate. As a minimum we recommend we commence filling the pool as soon as possible which we are ready to do so starting tomorrow afternoon.

We don't believe we will be filling the pool to a level which will prevent any inspections to be carried out by the ACT Government on Monday. We will also be leaving sufficient space so the water level does not impede with any works to the fourth expansion joint which is currently waiting on the ACT Government's direction.

Both Crystal Pools and Ceramic Solutions have been proactive in getting ahead of the programme as the an empty pool in an unstable environment has always been front of mind and a priority to fill it back up as soon as possible. The pool is currently stable with no tiles delamination and if the ACT Government decides put a hold on the refilling of the pool than we believe this is something which the ACT Government should bear as a risk.



It's very disappointing and unexpected to find the mess caused by your contractor. In addition to the photos below, attached are few additional photos for your reference.

As a result this issue, we highlight a number of concerns for your record and consideration.

- 1. Crystal Pool's workers arrived on site this morning with all their cleaning equipment to undertake the washing of the pool. As per Crystal Pool's email below, they cannot commence these works until the mess created by your contract has been resolved.
- 2. The amount of dust caused by your contractor cannot be left as is for various safety concerns. Our suggestion would be to put a hold the contractor works on the pool gutter and get them to rectify the issue immediately before it becomes a serious problem.
- 3. The filling of the pool is now on hold as a result of this issue and we remind you of the concerns revolving an empty pool in an unstable environment as per my email on 24 July.
- 4. There is a risk of corrosion to the pool plant and pool tiling due to a possible iron content in the blast materials by your contractor. This should all be totally removed prior to commencement of any pool washing or commissioning of the pool plant.

Since the very start our team has been committed in working with you to complete the repair works in a timely manner. No doubt that the above is serious in its nature which must be rectified immediately, our commitment to you remains unchanged. Moving forward, we suggest the following;

- Mess and dust caused by your contractor to be rectified / resolved today.
- Washing of the pool scheduled for today by Crystal Pools to be reviewed once the above is resolved.
   Filling of the pool, pending the above two points.
- Works to the fourth expansion joint continues as scheduled commencing this afternoon. Note as we understand the tilers will commence on the fourth joint this afternoon after 4pm. As a result, we expect some noise which may affect the operator and or it patrons. If you could please inform the operator that there may be some noisy works for 1 to 2 hours after 4pm today.
- Inspection as scheduled on Monday 29 July continues unchanged.
- Consider suspending the pool gutter painting works.

I have limited email access today however available via phone. We have always encouraged an open communication protocol with the repairs works so please do not hesitate to contact anyone of us direct i.e. Peter Stewart, Mark Huss, Ross Weight or myself should you need any assistance the above setback.

- Have all the personnel involved with the refurbishment work have working with vulnerable persons cards. We have previously discussed this at a meeting with the YMCA when we were all present. If they don't then, toilet and other site facilities will have to be provided in the loading bay area site compound.
- Other Remediation Work. Dot point 4 deck tile. We discussed the general marked up drawing regarding the pool deck tiles, I confirmed during our discussion on Monday 24 June 2019, that I believe the drummy tiles on the southern deck along the expansion joint are a defect and will need further investigation. I can't see that being a maintenance issue.





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

I was under the impression that the agreed scope of works was to replace the full row above and below this fourth expansion joint. Is this the case or was it to only to replace the drummy tiles, can you please confirm?
