More support to electrify your home

The Sustainable Household Scheme (SHS) loan cap has increased.

New applicants can now borrow up to \$20,000 to invest in energy-efficient upgrades and products for their home. These include electric heating and cooling systems, household battery storage systems and more.

Loans can also be used to buy a new or used electric vehicle or charging infrastructure. From September 2026, loans can also be used to buy electric cargo bikes.

SHS loans are low interest, with no upfront costs or fees. Participants have up to 10 years to pay off their loan (terms and conditions apply).

Next steps for UNSW Canberra City

The 2026–2027 ACT Budget supports the delivery of the new UNSW Canberra City campus in Reid.

Site preparation work has begun on the first stage of the project. A tower crane will be installed on site in the coming months.

Stage 1 includes construction of two new buildings that will deliver major education and research facilities. This stage is expected to be completed in 2028.

UNSW is already operating from the former CIT Reid site as work progresses.

When the new university campus is complete, it is expected to accommodate up to 5,000 students and 1,000 staff.

Period product dispensers for all ACT public schools

Dispensers for free period products are being installed in ACT public schools during term three.

This will enable every ACT public school student who needs to access period products to do so with dignity, privacy and confidence. Students can also access free period products at schools' front offices.

Free period products are available from a range of community locations across the ACT.

These include libraries, health and community services and some government facilities.

Next stage of Lake Ginninderra path improvements

Design work is progressing on the next stages of path upgrades around Lake Ginninderra.

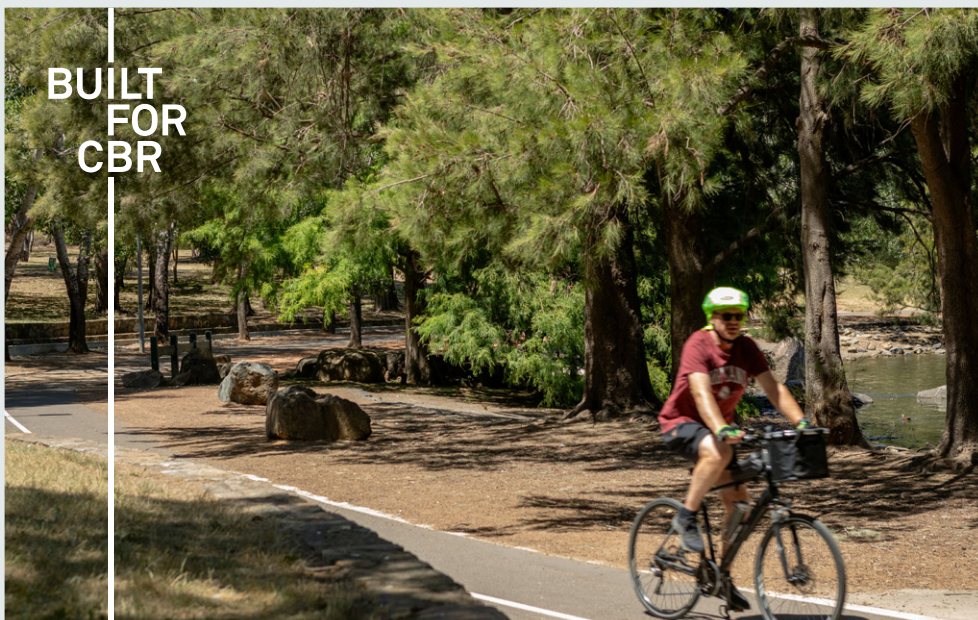
These include upgrades on the eastern peninsula and along the western foreshore.

Design work is expected to be complete in late 2026. Construction procurement will then begin.

This work will help ensure the paths around Lake Ginninderra remain a popular walking and cycling route.

Path upgrades through John Knight Memorial Park were completed in 2024.

Rapid bus routes return to west Belconnen

Rapid 2 and Rapid 3 bus services have returned to west Belconnen, restoring direct travel between Fraser and Fyshwick, and Spence and Canberra Airport.

Improvements to the network will retain the extended Rapid 5 and Rapid 6 services through Belconnen. They will also increase frequency on

key routes, delivering more capacity and reliability for the Belconnen community.

Rapid services run at least every 15 minutes between 7 am and 7 pm on weekdays, and frequently at other times.
