What is an Australian Apprenticeship?



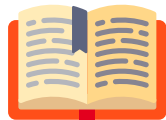
An Australian Apprenticeship includes both apprenticeships and traineeships and combines paid employment with gaining a nationally recognised qualification. Australian Apprenticeships are 'competency based' which means training can be completed as soon as the required skill level in the qualification is reached.

What do I get out of it?

Australian Apprenticeships are a way to become qualified in a trade or particular profession while you are working. They are a great way to get a head start in your chosen career. The job prospects for qualified people are vast as the demand for skilled workers increases. There are many benefits of gaining your qualification through an Australian Apprenticeship including:



- ▶ you can work and get paid while you're getting your qualification
- ▶ you get real life experience in the workplace which is priceless
- ▶ you have flexible training options such as on-the-job or off-the-job training, recognition of previous skills or a mixture of all of these
- ▶ you get a nationally recognised qualification that you can take anywhere in Australia and in some cases overseas
