

UTILITY RELOCATIONS ON LONDON CIRCUIT, CONSTITUTION AVENUE AND VERNON CIRCLE STARTING SOON

The ACT Government is building light rail to Woden to help make Canberra a more connected, sustainable, and vibrant city.

From around **20 September 2021** Cord Civil will start work to relocate utilities. It involves moving water mains and communications utilities from their current position along the southern portion of London Circuit, to a new alignment via Constitution Avenue, Vernon Circle and Edinburgh Avenue. This work is part of the Raising London Circuit and Light Rail to Woden program of works.


Diversions on London Circuit from 24-28 September

The first stage of works will be on Constitution Avenue with expected completion in November 2021. As part of this work, a section of London Circuit (see map below) will likely close from **Friday evening 24 September for 4 days to Tuesday afternoon**. Traffic will be diverted as per map below.

Temporary access changes to city carpark

An additional 1-2 nights of work will be required in early October. This will take place on a weekday. These works require temporary access changes to the carpark on the corner of London Circuit/Constitution Avenue.

What to expect

Traffic detours, road closures and car park changes:

- Temporary closure of London Circuit over a weekend and until Tuesday.
- Temporary lane closures on London Circuit outside of peak-hours.
- Changes to the car park on the corner of London Circuit and Constitution Avenue for the set-up of a construction site compound.
- Access changes to the London Circuit and Constitution Avenue car park for up to two nights.
- Reduced speed limits, changes to traffic flow and short-term traffic disruptions.
- Motorists are advised to follow directional signage and allow extra travel time.
- Traffic control will be in place.

Temporary lighting and audible noise:

- Machinery and saw cutting will be in use. Nearby residents and businesses should expect audible noise.
- Lighting towers will be used to light the area at night.
- Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during night working hours.

Cyclists, pedestrians and active travellers:

- Temporary pedestrian and cyclist crossings and signage will be in place.
- Pedestrians are encouraged to cross Constitution Avenue and London Circuit at signalised traffic lights.
- Pedestrian and cyclist paths to the car park and Theatre Lane will remain open.

Working hours

All construction activities are dependent on weather conditions. Expected working hours are:

- Night works: **24 28 September 2021** from Friday evening to Tuesday afternoon and up to two weekday nights in early October 2021.
- Day works: Monday to Friday, 6:30am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 7:00am to 1:00pm.

If additional night works are required, local businesses and residents will receive notifications prior to works occurring. Information on changes to construction activity will also be available at act.gov.au/lightrailtowoden
