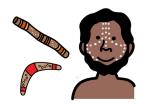

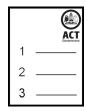

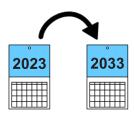
The ACT is the Australian Capital Territory.

• in the next 10 years

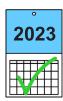


• in the ACT.

The Strategy says how we will make the ACT more accessible.

The Strategy also says how we will make the ACT more **inclusive**.

• that they belong like everyone else.

what makes life good

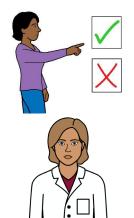


what makes life hard

# What did people tell us?



Many people said when you have a disability it can be hard to

- make your own choices in life
- find the doctors and therapists you need



- get good things to support you
  - for example, a wheelchair.



People also told us it can be hard to

- find good disability services
  - for example, services to help you live on your own



• meet and have fun with other people



- have enough money for everyday things
  - for example, to buy new clothes.

companies do not hire people with disability

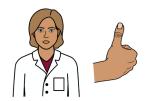


politicians forget about people with disability.

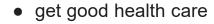
# What would make life better?

# What ideas did people have?

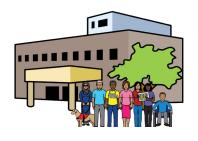


People had many ideas about what we should do next.

The people said we should write an action plan.

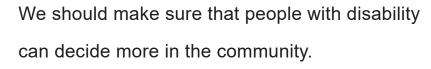
Action plan means a list of the things we will do first.

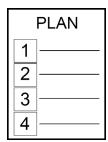
