Meeting 10 of the Labour Hire Licensing Advisory Committee

The Committee which was established under the *Labour Hire Licensing Act 2020* (the Act) meets biannually, and includes representatives from government, industry, and unions.

SUMMARY OF DISCUSSIONS

Members were welcomed to the tenth meeting of the Committee and acknowledged the traditional custodians of the ACT.

WorkSafe ACT provided an update from the Labour Hire Licence Commissioner on administration of the labour hire licensing scheme under the *Labour Hire Licensing Act 2020*, including updates on new and renewed licences, as well as conditional licences issued to date and compliance activities.

Members discussed the national harmonisation of labour hire licensing schemes, noting delays in progress.

Members also commenced discussions about the next Business Plan of the Committee, including the consideration of the scheme's compliance toolkit and infringement notice penalties.

The next meeting of the Committee was scheduled for Tuesday, 14 October 2025.
