Services available during the holiday season

If you find yourself with a non-life-threatening injury or illness over the festive season, head to your local Walk-in Centre.

ACT Walk-in Centres are open seven days a week, including Christmas Day and New Year's Day, between 7.30 am and 10 pm. This service is free and you do not need an appointment.

Some ACT Government services will be closed or have restricted opening hours during the holiday period.

This includes Access Canberra Service Centres, although online transactions can still be carried out at any time.

Walk-in Centres are part of the Medicare Urgent Care Clinic Network.


Garran Primary School update

The first stage of the Garran Primary School modernisation and expansion project is complete.

The school moved into new buildings in November. Students and staff are enjoying flexible learning spaces, a new library, science and technology labs, and a rooftop garden.

Stage 2 of the project will start soon. This includes demolishing the old school and building a new double gymnasium, canteen, music and dance spaces, as well as external learning play areas and green spaces.

The project is due for completion by the end of 2026.





Better roads for the region
