FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your two applications under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by Infrastructure Canberra (iCBR) on 26 March 2026.

In your information access request's, you sought access to:

Application one: *All documents including communication between CMTEDD or the Minister for Economic Development and Infrastructure Canberra relating to business cases around a Canberra Stadium, and*

Application two: *All documents including communication between CMTEDD or the Minister for Economic Development and Infrastructure Canberra relating to business cases around the Canberra stadium site at Bruce.*

On 7 April 2026, in accordance with Ombudsman Guidelines, your two applications were combined into a single request confirmed as follows:

"Correspondence between CMTEDD and iCBR regarding a Canberra Stadium Business Case"

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, iCBR is required to provide a decision on your access application within 30 days. Therefore, a decision is due by 13 May 2026.

Decision on access

Searches were completed using the information you provided.

No correspondence between Infrastructure Canberra and CMTEDD was returned regarding a Business Case for any Canberra Stadium since the formation of Infrastructure Canberra (November 2025).

In the interest of an open and transparent government a secondary search was conducted to include correspondence between "Major Project Canberra" and CMTEDD regarding a Canberra Stadium Business Case.

I am satisfied that appropriate searches were completed and that no material relevant to the scope of your request are held by iCBR.
