FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by Major Projects Canberra (MPC) via partial transfer from Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 1 June 2021, in which you sought access to documents:

In relation to contract 2017.28567.401 – Stormwater Improvement Program 2016/2017 Package A GPT Retrofit Lyneham Wetland – TCCS – Contract – No – Expired – 10/3/2017 – 2/6/2018 - \$67,254.00 – Complex Co. Pty Ltd:

- *digital copies of all reports, surveys, modelling, documents outlining scope and any changes to scope that was prepared for this project; and*
- *any reports that lead to the works/issuing contracts*

(Note: It was agreed that MPC were to provide final reports only – no drafts are required and that the scope does not include procurement documentation (RFQ, tender evaluation plans)

In relation to this access request zero (0) documents were found to be within the scope of the request.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Chief Projects Officer under section 18 of the Act to deal with access application made under Part 5 of the Act. This decision is made pursuant to section 36 of the Act.
