# Light Rail to Woden Construction Update

March 2023



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## **Construction notification**

The ACT Government is investing in infrastructure to benefit the lives of all Canberrans. The Light Rail to Woden project is being Built for CBR to create a more connected, sustainable, and vibrant city. This construction notification provides an update on expected activity in the work zones for March on Raising London Circuit – an enabling project for light rail to Woden.

As part of the Raising London Circuit project, works must take place to install stormwater pipes and pits and to remove streetlights on the southeast off-ramp from Parkes Way eastbound to Commonwealth Avenue. Full ramp closures will be required in March to complete this work. The off-ramp closures will be in place from:

- 10am Tuesday, 21 March to 7am Tuesday, 28 March
- 8pm Friday, 31 March to 7am Monday, 3 April (contingency).

Full ramp closures are required at these times due to the extent of the excavation works and to undertake the work safely. The weeklong closure will allow significant work to be completed at once, reducing the number of weekend closures that would be required otherwise. Work will take place 24 hours a day while closures are in place to accomplish as much as possible in the allowed time. If works are impacted by wet weather or other delays, they will be postponed to the following week.

### Upcoming work

Activities during each closure will include:

- 1. Traffic control set up and off-ramp closed.
- 2. Excavation of required area, installation of stormwater pipes and pits. Streetlights removal.
- 3. Reinstatement of area, including asphalting and concrete pouring.
- 4. Site demobilised, and off-ramp reopened.

#### How will this work affect you?

The Parkes Way off-ramp will be fully closed at the indicated times. Detours will be in place via Coranderrk Street and Constitution Avenue. Travellers can also use Kings Avenue Bridge to access South Canberra. There will be no lane closures on Parkes Way as a result of the work. Traffic control and pedestrian diversions will be in place throughout the work. Equipment used will include trucks, excavators, road saws, hand tools and light vehicles.


