FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by Infrastructure Canberra (iCBR).

In your information access request, you sought access to:

“Provide data on the mean (average) tender submission price (GST inclusive), and the median tender submission price (GST Inclusive) for the following tenders where there are 4+ number of conforming tenders”

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Decision on access

A request was made to the Tender Evaluation Team to provide the data you requested. Data was provided for seven of the nine projects. Two of the tender evaluations are not yet finalised, mean and median tender prices for those projects are not available.

Statement of Reasons

In making my decision on disclosing government information, I must identify all relevant factors in Schedule 2 of the Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies.

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

Factors favouring disclosure in the public interest (Schedule 2, Section 2.1)

- Section 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability; and
- Section 2.1(a)(iv) – ensure effective oversight of expenditure of public funds;

I am satisfied that these are relevant considerations favouring disclosure in this case, and in the interests of enhancing open discussion, I afford them significant weight.

Charges

I have decided to waive any charges in relation to this Freedom of Information application.

Online Publishing – Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the Act, iCBR maintains an official online record of access applications called a Disclosure Log. Your original access application, my decision and documents released to you in response to your access application will be published on the iCBR Disclosure Log within three to ten working days after the date of the decision.

Ombudsman Review
