

MORE INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS FOR CANBERRA

Canberrans can soon fly Qatar Airways between Doha and Canberra when its daily service begins in mid-February.

The airline will fly a Boeing 777-300 daily from Canberra to Sydney and then onto Doha. The new service enhances the ACT Government's focus on expanding international connections.



Green waste collections will start in Belconnen in September 2018. Residents will be invited to register for their green bin later in the year.

A one-off registration fee of \$50 will be required. Eligible concession card holders are exempt from payment. Green waste collections are already in place in Weston Creek and Tuggeranong. Collections for all other parts of Canberra will start around mid-2019.


