Huon Contractors is working on behalf of Major Projects Canberra (MPC) to relocate utilities and upgrade local roads in preparation for a new transport interchange to be built on Callam Street. We would like to notify you about upcoming works to be undertaken outside of regular working hours.

Out of Hours Works 4 nights between 31 May 2022 to 3 June 2022

SERVICE RELOCATION WORKS

From Tuesday 31 May 2022 to Friday 3 June 2022, we will be undertaking out of hours works (between 8:00pm – 6:00am) to enable services along Callam Street to be relocated.

These works include excavation and installation of a new Evo Energy electricity service at the driveway to the Woden Police Station and Woden Youth Centre on Callam Street. The works are required to be undertaken outside of regular construction hours so as not to restrict access to the carpark during business operations, with temporary access to be restored each morning.

A range of construction machinery will be used to complete these works, including a road saw, hydro-vacuum trucks, excavators and small tipper trucks.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to the local community during these works. Noise will be kept to a minimum as much as possible, with machines turned off when not in use and general site noise closely monitored.

We thank you for your co-operation in relation to these works and apologise for these inconveniences which are necessary to deliver the new transport interchange.
