### AMENDMENT TO FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), released to you on 14 August 2025.

In your information access request, you sought access to:

*“Provide data on the mean (average) tender submission price (GST inclusive), and the median tender submission price (GST Inclusive) for the following tenders where there are 4+ number of conforming tenders”*

At the time of release two of the tender evaluations were not yet finalised, and the mean and median tender prices for those projects were not available. On 18 August 2025 you have requested the remaining two tenders be included for release when available.

This amendment decision is pursuant under section 36(3)(b) of the Freedom of Information Act.

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.
