

Light Rail to Woden Construction Update

Monthly Look Ahead for August 2022

The ACT Government is building light rail to Woden to help make Canberra a more connected, sustainable, and vibrant city. This construction look ahead provides a summary of expected activity in the work zones for the month ahead on raising London Circuit – an enabling project for light rail to Woden.



Update – early works on raising London Circuit

Early utility relocation works on raising London Circuit are winding down and nearing completion in the next few months.

Works to connect the watermain at the Constitution Avenue and London Circuit intersection are complete. We will now reinstate the area to how it was before construction started.

Demobilisation of the second compound on Marcus Clarke Street is now complete and the area has been reinstated to how it was before works started.

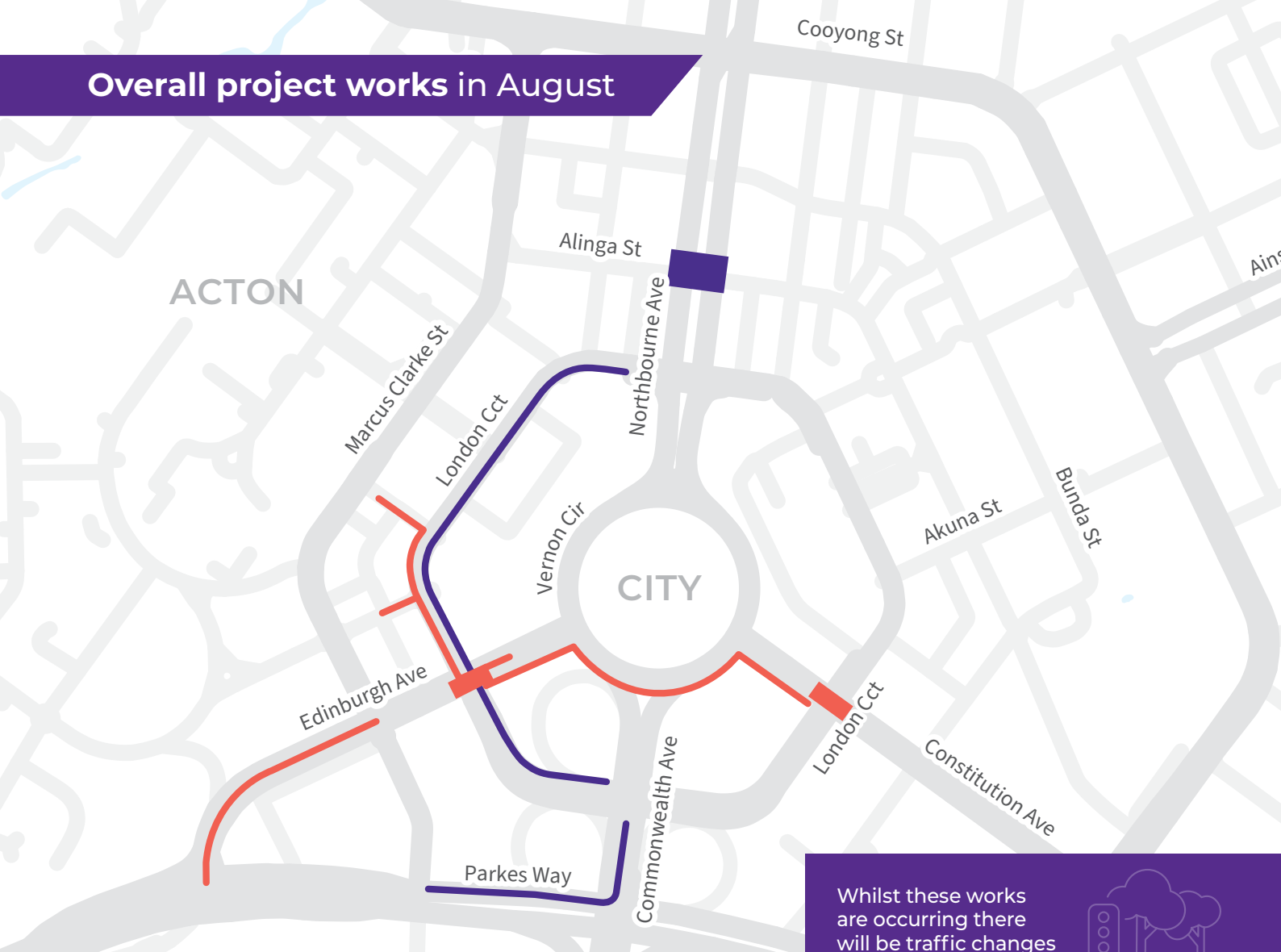
Telecommunications providers continue to undertake connections with new and existing infrastructure. Whilst these works are occurring there will be traffic changes and pedestrian and traffic management in place to ensure safety.

Service providers undertaking connections will issue a notification to customers if there are any scheduled impacts to existing services.



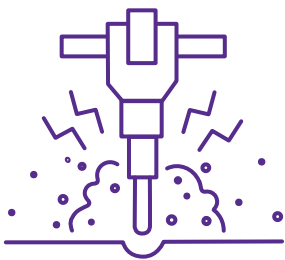
Overall project works in August

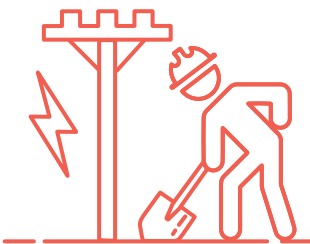

Ground Investigation works

Potholing and survey investigation works will continue along London Circuit to investigate ground and underground conditions. These investigations involve minor excavation works,

survey pickup and surface reinstatement. As part of this work, traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place.



Telecommunications works

TPG needs to carry out some remaining conduit and trenching work along the London Circuit verge at the locations outlined on the map:

- Farrell Place between London Cct and William Clemens St.
- Gordon St between London Cct and William Clemens St.
- Edinburgh Ave between London Cct and The Mews.

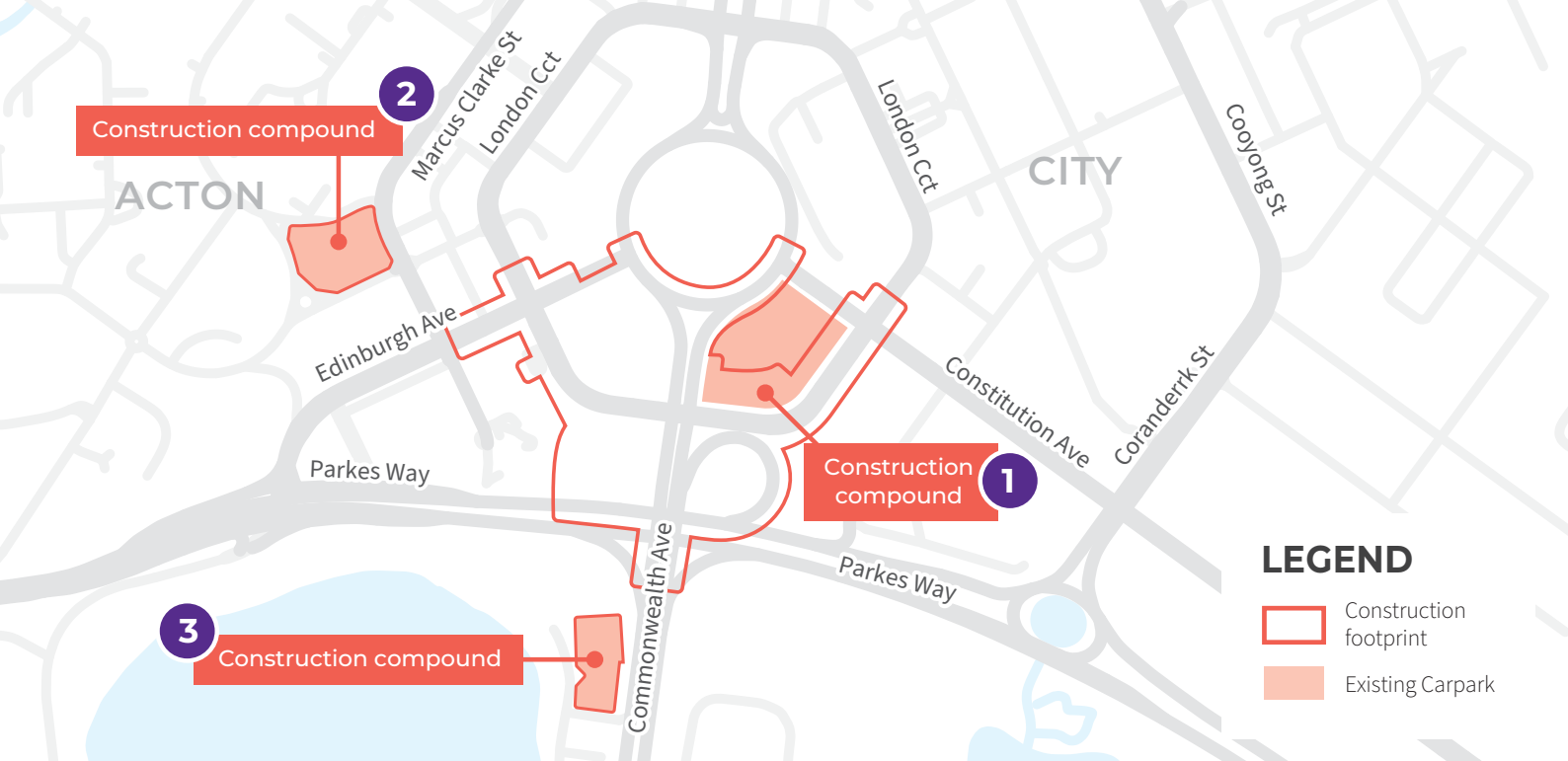
Cable installation work will also take place along Edinburgh Avenue between Parkes Way

and Vernon Circle, along Vernon Circle and part of Constitution Ave, as indicated on the map.

To safely undertake this work, traffic management, including road and lane closures will be in place.

This work will be undertaken Monday to Friday 7:00am to 6:00pm and on Saturdays between 7:00am and 1:00pm.

What's next - Raising London Circuit

With early utility relocation works finishing in the next few months, construction contractor, Abergeldie Contractors is preparing all the necessary plans, processes, permits and approvals needed to get started later this year on the main works.

You may start to see some site preparations commence in the coming months. These activities will include starting the set up of fenced off construction compounds that are used for site offices, storage, deliveries, amenities and machinery parking. The establishment of site compounds will result in temporary reduced public parking.

In line with planning approvals, the raising London Circuit project is planning three site compounds using space within the following carparks:

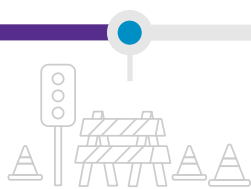
- 1 Corner of Constitution Avenue and London Circuit
- 2 Marcus Clarke Street
- 3 Acton Waterfront

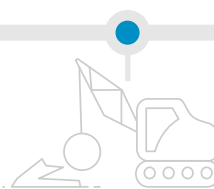

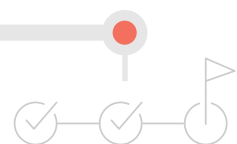

Night Works

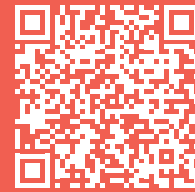
Sewer investigations for light rail

Closed Circuit Television Video (CCTV) inspections of the sewer mains will continue to understand the conditions of the underground utilities. This work will take place throughout the city. Refer to the map for the investigation areas.

- > To ensure safety and minimise impacts on the community, this work will take place at night from Sunday to Friday between 8:00pm and 6:00am. Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place. We will make every effort to minimise the impacts of noise.
- > Works are anticipated to continue in August. Exact dates and times will be published online at act.gov.au/lightrailtowoden/construction

Geotechnical Investigations – reduced carparking near the Canberra Theatre

As part of a new project to build Canberra's new theatre, some geotechnical investigations will be carried out for approximately two weeks in August.

The geotechnical investigations involve the drilling of a series of boreholes. These works will be done between 7am and 4pm Monday to Friday and will not impact roads.

With some of the drilling being done in the existing surface carpark next to the Canberra Theatre, there will be minor loss of carparking as the works team establishes temporary exclusion zones at each borehole.

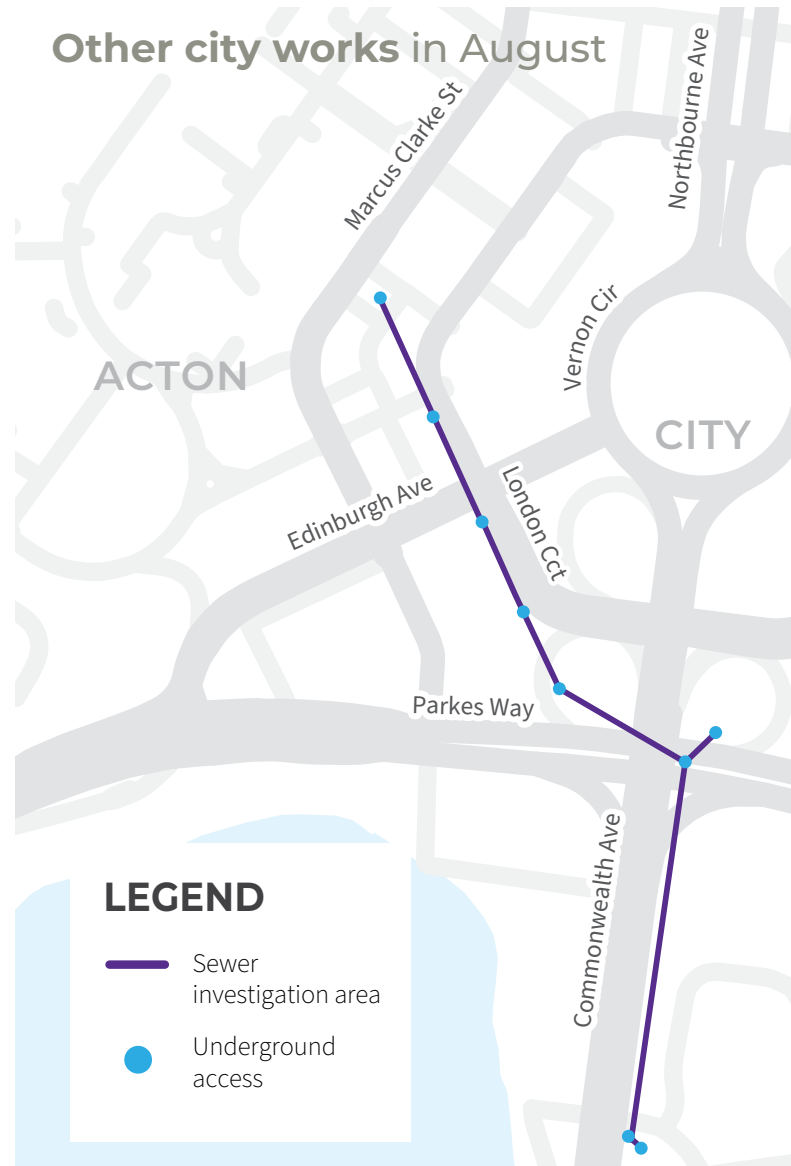
