Care	Budgeting for life	Budgeting for Life is a series of workshops designed to improve participants' numeracy and learning skills. The program involves skill development in budgeting, saving, accessing services, and personal development.	\$91,501.89
Conflict Resolution Service	Work education communication and negotiation (WE CAN) program	WE CAN is an innovative education program creating dynamic and supported learning environments. By incorporating games and hands on activities, participants explore and develop skills in communication, collaboration, negotiation, and conflict resolution. This program builds participants' core skills necessary for sustainable employability.	\$100,000.00
Master Builders Association (MBA) Group Training in partnership with the Migrant and Refugee Settlement Services (MARSS)	Kickstart to construction	Kickstart to Construction links migrants and refugees to jobs in the building and construction industry. This is achieved by participants completing targeted foundation skills learning. Participants will gain English language skills targeted towards enabling participants to be construction worksite ready. This training includes mandatory training requirements and WHS training. MBA is partnering with the Migrant and Refugee Settlement Services (MARSS) to deliver the program.	\$99,520.00
Support Asian Women's Friendship Association	Open doors - CALD adults learning computer and English skills for work	The Open Doors project provides training in reading, writing, numeracy, oral communication, workplace conversational English and computer skills. The program assists adults from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, who are not currently employed, to develop workplace computer and English language skills.	\$84,446.11
Woden Community Service	Skills for life	The Skills for Life program takes a long-term approach to supporting vulnerable people to become job ready. The project is designed to establish a clear and tangible pathway to support people to improve their existing language, literacy, and numeracy (LLN), and employability skills. This prepares them to undertake further nationally recognised certificate and industry specific courses to increase their job readiness.	\$75,000.00
YWCA Canberra	The confidence, care, and clarity program – helping women and non-binary people navigate pathways to success.	The Confidence, Care and Clarity Program is an eight-week face-to-face program designed to engage female, female-identifying and non-binary community members facing barriers to employment, training and education.
