
## FACELIFT FOR ANKETELL STREET

Stage one upgrades to Anketell Street will be underway early next year.

The works include new furniture, street trees and feature lighting, as well as improved pedestrian access to the laneway entry to the lake.

This first stage of the upgrade is part of a long term plan to revitalise the Tuggeranong Town Centre's public spaces, and is based on the Tuggeranong Town Centre Master Plan.

Construction will start mid-year and be completed by the end of 2017.

## MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF MINISTER, ANDREW BARR


When the first flight from Singapore landed on a wet Canberra day a couple of months ago, our city changed for the better. We became a globally connected city.

## **NEW SECURE MENTAL HEALTH UNIT** 'DHULWA' OPENS

#### Dhulwa, the secure mental health unit in Symonston officially commenced operations in November.

Dhulwa is the first unit of its type in our region and has capacity for 25 residents. This includes 10 acute care beds and 15 rehabilitation beds, as well as 24-hour clinical support.

Dhulwa is a Ngunnawal term meaning 'honey suckle', a native plant with healing properties.






## CELEBRATE CHRISTMAS IN THE CITY
