

Review of the Canberra Institute of Technology's Governance

Terms of Reference

The Review will examine the governance arrangements for the Canberra Institute of Technology (CIT) with a view to how the CIT can best deliver on the needs of ACT learners and the community.

The Terms of Reference are as follows:

- a) The Review will examine governance frameworks including legislative and policy arrangements to optimise governance for the future of the CIT;
- b) It will consider relevant risk, policy and legislative frameworks and practices;
- c) The Review will have regard to governance arrangements in similar contexts, including at equivalent institutions in other Australian jurisdictions; and
- d) Identify optimal governance structures, roles and responsibilities that would strengthen appropriate oversight, decision-making, accountability and organisational effectiveness.

The following matters are outside the scope of this Review:

- The Review will have regard to the scope and outcomes of previous scrutiny processes, but will not re-examine recent enquiries and scrutiny processes
- CIT legislated functions and policy objectives beyond governance considerations
- Day-to-day CIT activities such as operational management, administration, teaching staff, training delivery and outcomes.
