The Canberra Hospital expansion is well underway and on track for completion in 2024. The government is also introducing a digital health record system to allow clinical staff to spend less time looking for medical records and more time looking after patients.

For the future, planning is underway for a new northside hospital and the government is continuing to invest in the network of nurse-led walk-in centres.

Hospital expansion taking shape

Construction of the new eight-storey Critical Services Building is well underway.

The concrete structure will reach full height by early next year. Work will then continue on the façade and fit out of spaces to provide the Canberra Hospital with more operating rooms, more treatment spaces and more intensive care beds.

Once complete in 2024, the new state-of-the-art Critical Services Building will boost healthcare capacity for Canberra and the surrounding regions.

Digital Health Record goes live

The new Digital Health Record goes live across the ACT's public health system from 12 November.

Every Canberran will have a Digital Health Record that can be accessed by their healthcare team at any ACT public health service, allowing clinical staff to spend less time looking for medical records and more time looking after patients.

Individuals will also be able to access their own Digital Health Record through MyDHR, enabling them to update their information, check test results or manage appointments.

Changes in the city

As construction works increase on light rail related projects in the city, Canberrans are reminded to plan their journeys and stay informed.

Temporary traffic lights are being installed at the junction of Northbourne Avenue and Vernon Circle to allow safe movements onto Constitution Avenue and London Circuit.

London Circuit will soon be temporarily closed between Edinburgh Avenue and Constitution Avenue to safely carry out work to raise London Circuit.

Now targeting illegal dumping

Canberrans are being encouraged to dispose of waste thoughtfully, with cameras set up at illegal dumping hot spots across Canberra to help deter and detect offenders.

Strong penalties apply for those caught dumping material illegally.

Canberrans have many options to reuse, donate or dispose of unwanted items, including a free annual bulky waste collection of up to two cubic metres for ACT households.

As the suburb of Whitlam grows, design and planning is underway for a new public primary school and early childhood education and care centre, scheduled to open in time for the 2025 school year.

Changes coming to Woden interchange

Construction of a temporary bus interchange is underway in Woden.

Located to the east of the Matilda Street car park, the temporary interchange will allow bus operations to continue when construction on the new light rail ready interchange starts in early 2023.

Passengers will be kept up to date via ACT Government social channels, websites and with onsite assistance.

This work is part of the major CIT Campus project in the Woden town centre.

The campus will provide a state-of-the-art CIT facility, new parks, green spaces and a youth foyer to support vulnerable Canberrans to study.
