Message from the Chief Minister

National cost-of-living pressures are causing financial challenges for many Canberra households.

There are ACT Government programs to help Canberrans with everyday costs including energy bills, health care and transport. There are also programs to assist with sustainable home upgrades and support to rent or buy a home.

The recent ACT Budget included further cost of living relief, including expanding the Utilities Concession eligibility criteria to support more households with the costs of heating and cooling their homes. Around one in five Canberra households are now eligible for support with their energy bills.

Refreshed website provides support

The ACT Government's cost of living website makes it easier for eligible Canberrans to find support for energy, rates, education, health and transport costs.

Apply for help with energy bills

If you have an eligible concession card, you can apply for the Utilities Concession. This will give you up to \$800 off your energy bills in 2023–24. You can apply via your energy provider.

The Utilities Concession is applied to your electricity bill and covers electricity, natural gas, water and sewerage and is calculated on a daily basis, with rates depending on the season.

Get free health care at a Walk-in Centre

Canberrans can receive free health care at one of Canberra's five Walk-in Centres.

Nurses provide free assessment and treatment of non-life-threatening injuries and illnesses.

Anyone over one year of age can attend – with or without a Medicare card.

The centres are open 365 days a year, 7.30am to 10pm, in Belconnen, Tuggeranong, Dickson, Weston and Gungahlin. No appointment is necessary.

Initiatives to help reduce your cost of living

The ACT Government has a number of initiatives available to help support eligible Canberrans with the cost of living. These include:

- Assistance with the cost of energy bills via the Utilities Concession
- Free or discounted travel on ACT public transport
- Rates rebate or deferral
- Help paying for school essentials via the Education Equity Fund
- Discounted vehicle registration and licence renewal
- Free health care at a Walk-in Centre
- Interest-free rental bond loans
- Fee-free TAFE to train, retrain or upskill
- Free advice to save money on home energy and water bills.

Progress continues on the **Molonglo River Bridge**

Design work is progressing on the John Gorton Drive extension and Molonglo River Bridge.

You may have noticed activity near Coppins Crossing as work to support the design takes place.

Once complete, the bridge will become Australia's longest weathering steel bridge, and Canberra's highest road bridge.

This project is also delivering:

- bus queue jump lanes and two bus stops
- off-road shared paths
- a new intersection connecting to the Molonglo Group Centre
- new native animal habitat.

Path improvement work will soon begin across Chifley, from Melrose Drive to the Tuggeranong Parkway.

Part of the Age Friendly Suburbs Program, the work aims to improve path access for older Canberrans and people with mobility needs, as well as the community as a whole.

Full steam ahead on CIT and interchange work

Construction is progressing on the new CIT campus and public transport interchange in Woden. Concrete is being poured for the basement and the first tower crane is on site. Storm water works are underway on Callam Street.

The second tower crane will soon arrive, and the concrete slab poured to support the building's north pod. This will house specialist learning areas for hairdressing and beauty therapy, creative design, and media and music.
