Cotter Dam, parts of the reserve and suspension bridge Blocks 29, 30, 34, 38, 39 COREE

An important aspect of the Cotter Avenue experience was the original swing bridge constructed in the early 1900's to provide access across the Cotter River, which was sadly destroyed in the 2003 bushfires. The replacement of this historically significant bridge has formed a key element in the reinstatement of Cotter Avenue, and provides access across Cotter River to the Cotter Dam Discovery Trail.
