Dear Canberrans,

Responding to the spread of COVID-19 is the greatest challenge our city has faced.

We all have an important role to play to flatten the curve and slow the spread of COVID-19 in the Territory.

Staying at home as much as possible, avoiding crowds and adhering to physical distancing if you need to leave for essential supplies, healthcare needs, exercise or for work and study is the best way you can protect yourself, your family and those around you. I want to thank Canberrans for their efforts so far.

Behind the scenes there is a huge collective effort underway to keep our city operating. Canberrans will have access to the services we need – supermarkets will stay open as will other essential services like pharmacies, petrol stations, banks and post offices. We will keep the power on and the water running. Critical work to increase the COVID-19 response capacity across the ACT's health system is continuing.

The ACT and Commonwealth Governments are working together to provide significant financial support for Canberra households and businesses that are facing financial hardship during this time.
