

Labour Hire Licensing Advisory Committee

Public Communique

Meeting 12 of the Labour Hire Licensing Advisory Committee

24 April 2026

The Labour Hire Licensing Advisory Committee (the Committee) advises the Minister for Skills, Training and Industrial Relations on matters relating to the *Labour Hire Licensing Act 2020* (the Act) and the ACT labour hire industry. The Committee, which was established under the Act, meets biannually and includes representatives from government, industry, and unions.

SUMMARY OF DISCUSSIONS

The Chair welcomed Members to the twelfth meeting of the Committee and acknowledged the traditional custodians of the ACT.

Members endorsed the minutes from Meeting 10, held on 28 May 2025.

Members were provided an update from the Labour Hire Licence Commissioner on administration of the labour hire licensing scheme under the Act, including updates on new and renewed licences, conditional licences issued to date and compliance activities.

Members considered offences and penalties under the labour hire scheme, in particular infringement notice penalties as an alternative to prosecution.

Members endorsed the Committee's governance documentation, including the 2026-28 Business Plan, and updates to the Terms of Reference and the Operation and Accountability Guidelines.

Members noted that discussions were underway in relation to harmonised national principles for labour hire licensing regulation.

The next meeting of the Committee is scheduled for Friday, 16 October 2026.
